SUBJECT: Title 22 Regulations Compliance

Multi-Year Contract for Substance Use Disorder Services for Fiscal Years 2014-2015 through 2016-2017

PROCEDURE:

As part of its efforts to comply with the audit requirements set forth in Multi-Year Contract for Substance Use Disorder Services for Fiscal Years 2014-2015 through 2016-2017 and the California Code of Regulations Title 22, Division 3, Subdivision 1, Chapter 3, Article 4, Section 51341.1 Drug Medi-Cal Substance Use Disorder Services, the County of Orange Behavioral Health Services and its Substance Use Disorder Services (SUDS) Programs will:

1. Establish and require its subcontractors to establish written procedures consistent with the requirements specified in Title 22, CFR, Division 4, Section 51341.1;
2. Monitor for compliance with the written procedures; and
3. Be held accountable for audit exceptions taken by the State against the County and its Subcontractors for any failure to comply with those requirements.
