## OCEAN WATER CLOSURE

**(Santa Ana) –**

The County of Orange Health Care Agency, Environmental Health, has closed the ocean water area in the City of Laguna Beach from 300 feet upcoast to 300 feet downcoast of Aliso Creek at Aliso County Beach due to a sewage spill. The spill of approximately 800 gallons was caused by a line blockage in the Moulton Niguel Water District sewer collection system.

The affected ocean water area will remain closed to ocean water-contact sports until the results of follow-up water quality monitoring meet acceptable standards.
