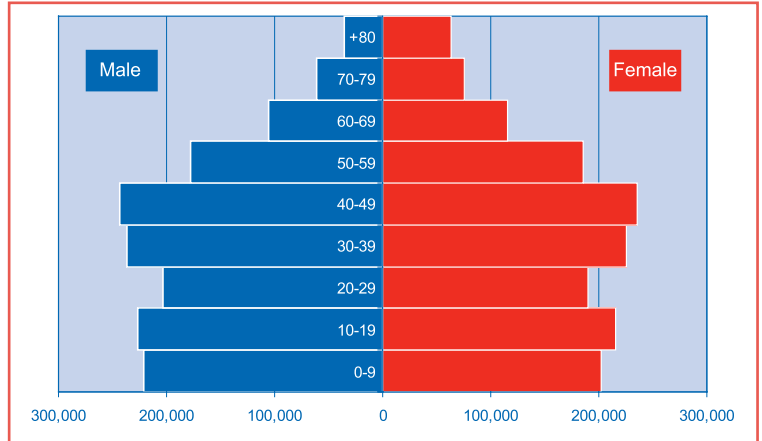

Figure #1 shows the age and gender distribution of Orange County's total population. Overall, 50% of the population is female. When looking more closely at the age cohorts, males outnumber females in first ten cohorts (0 to 49). From age 50 on, females outnumber males. This supports the generally known fact that females tend to live longer than males.

Children ages 0 to 9 comprise 14.3% (435,706) of the total population and youth and young adults age 10-19 comprise 14.6% (446,938) of the total population. Children and youth 0-17 years of age, as reported on page 16, comprise 26.2% (801,536) of the total population.

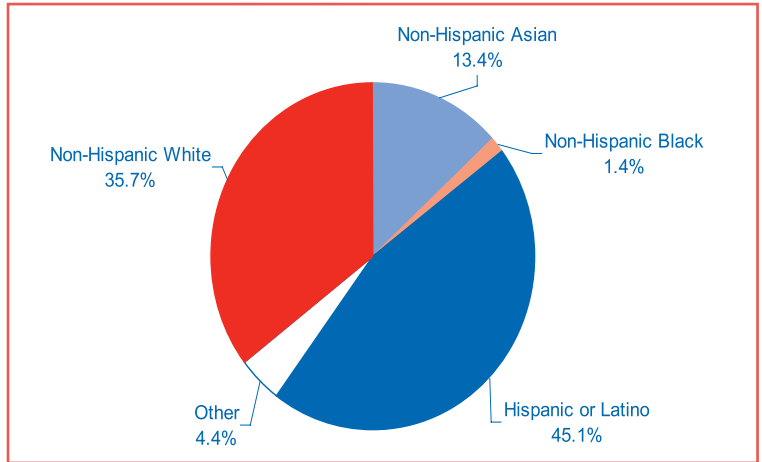
In Figure #2, the distribution of the County's youth population by race and ethnicity is shown. The largest racial group is the Hispanic or Latino category with 45.1%. The next largest category is the Non-Hispanic White, 35.7%. The third largest race category is Non-Hispanic Asian with 13.4% of Orange County's population. These are followed by the Other Category (4.4%), and Non-Hispanic Black (1.4%).
