In 2006, California Senate Bill 699 (Soto) was passed, requiring California health care providers and laboratories to report cases of HIV infection by name instead of the code based method that began in July 2002. The new reporting requirements are consistent with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations that all states and territories report HIV infection using a confidential name-based system. As of April 17, 2006, County of Orange, Health Care Agency, HIV/AIDS Surveillance and Monitoring Program only reports statistics based on HIV cases reported by name.
