They offer most kinds of health services. • They offer preventive check-ups, immunizations (shots), sick care, specialty care, and prescriptions. • Some also cover hospital stays, dental and vision care, mental health and other services. 						<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • These programs are not like health insurance. They only cover some basic health needs like preventive check-ups and needed follow-ups. All give immunizations (shots). Some provide care for sick children. 		
What is the cost?	• No monthly cost, no co-payments.	• \$4-\$15 per child monthly (max. \$45 monthly per family). • \$5 co-payment for some services.	• \$8 or \$15 per child, per month for up to 3 children; depending on family size and income. • No cost for additional children • \$5 co-payment.	• \$15 monthly per child in the family. • \$5-\$35 for the services	• The cost is 1.5% of the one-year's household income (before taxes) divided into monthly payments.	• \$10/month/child Premium (no family max.). • Quarterly Premiums (1st payment due with application).	• Free check-ups, immunizations and some related treatment.	• Free check-ups, immunizations and some related treatment. • \$5 for sick care visits.	• Low cost or free.
