SUBJECT: NEW POLICIES and CLARIFICATIONS/UPDATES OF EXISTING EMS

DOCUMENTS

Typically, the Orange County EMS Agency reviews, updates, and edits its policies, procedures, and standing orders on a biannual basis. New policies may also be added. These activities occurred in April of 2021. From time to time, the agency may also need to issue updates on an impromptu basis, as such actions can't wait until the next cycle. This also occurred in July of 2021. It is now time to publish our next scheduled update. I am listing, immediately below, the documents that will be added to the Upcoming section of our website https://www.ochealthinfo.com/ems) for October 1, 2021.

For this particular cycle only, however, those documents previously posted in the April and July update will remain in the Upcoming section for an addition 6 months. In other words, all the following polices, procedures, and standing orders listed in this letter will remain as optional until April 1, 2022. Agencies, providers, and businesses will not be required to implement these new directives until then. I am placing those documents previously placed in the Upcoming section here again as a reminder.
