The County of Orange Environmental Health Division is the Administering Agency for the California Accidental Release Prevention (CalARP) Program for all of the Orange County Cities except for Anaheim and La Habra. CalARP regulations requires companies with certain regulated chemicals above a reporting threshold to submit a Risk Management Plan (RMP) to the County for review.

Upon determination that the RMP is complete by CUPA staff, notice will be provided to the public that the RMP is now available for 45 day public comment period.
