Notification of a Medical Waste Temporary Event

The Medical Waste Management Act (MWMA) allows for the generation of medical waste at a temporary event without further permits or registration, if the medical waste generator is currently registered with the local enforcement agency. Notification is required at least 72 hours before the temporary event.
