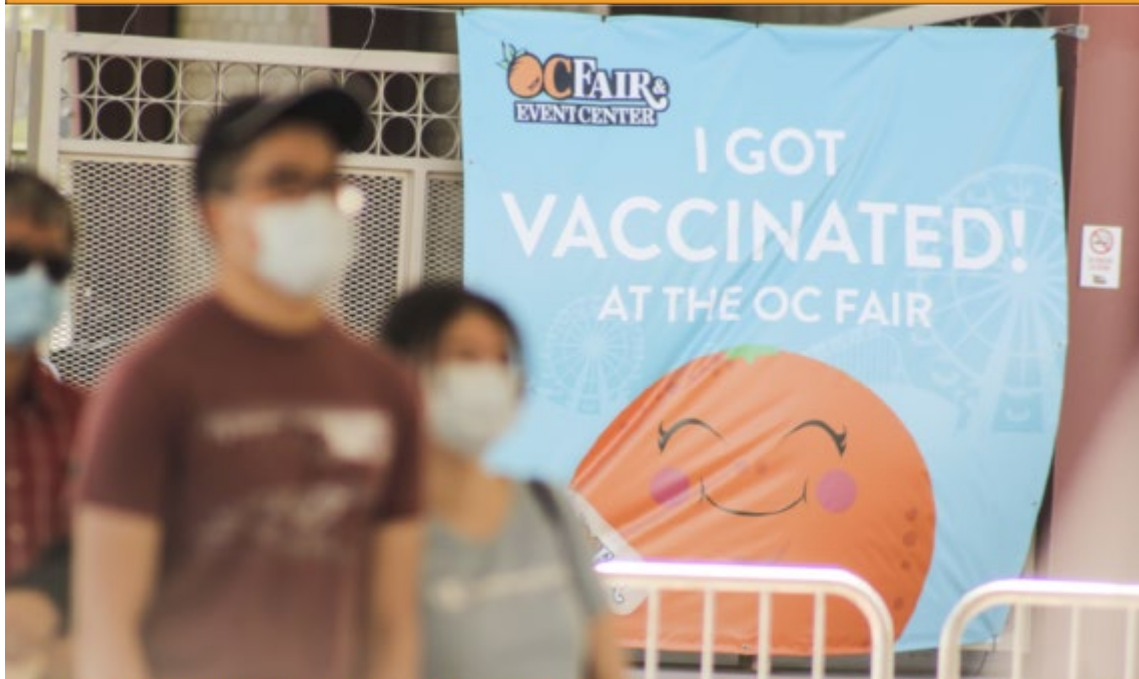

VACCINE FACTS & TIPS



TIP: The Better Business Bureau advises against posting your vaccination card on social media because the information it contains can make you vulnerable to identity theft and help scammers create phony versions. Instead, they offer some other ways you can share the news that you've received the vaccine.

FACT: After COVID-19 vaccination, you may have some side effects. These are normal signs that your body is building immunity. Your arm may hurt where you got your shot or you may have redness or swelling. You may feel tired or have a headache, muscle pain, chills, fever, or nausea. Such side effects should pass in a few days. [Learn more.](#)



FACT: The CDC recommends you should be vaccinated regardless of whether you already had COVID-19. That's because experts do not yet know how long you are protected from getting sick again after recovering from COVID-19. It is possible—although rare—that you could be infected with the virus that causes COVID-19 again. [Learn more.](#)
