**ALTERNATE CARE SITE – FAIRVIEW / FAIRGROUNDS**

- State released a Data Modeling Book & based on hospital’s reported ability to surge higher than expected, the number of ACS sites has decreased OC (PPT & report attached).
  - Phase 1 – state focus on ACS-acute level care & resourcing USN Mercy, LA Surge Hospitals, Fairview. Plan to shift Mercy staff to Fairview. Fairview Bldgs D, E, F that were to be used for IDD patients will now be ACS
  - Phase 2 – Fairgrounds-may be used/resourced & fully supported by County if changes in projections indicate
