SKILLED NURSING FACILITY OUTBREAK STATUS (CalOES to post stats later this week)

- Confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SNFs: 130 (75 residents & 55 staff)
 - Outbreaks: Anaheim Healthcare Center, Huntington Valley SNF
 - PH mobile teams are available to assist SNFs w/ specimen collection & testing if the SNF is unable to test symptomatic residents.
- Goal is to support SNFs w/ resources (staff & PPE) to maintain operations
 - HCA has established multiple nursing/staff registries to support SNF staffing; SNFs are reporting large numbers of staff resignations
 - OCEMS has established standby EMTs to support SNFs during crises
- Emergency evacuations will occur with local ambulance strike team(s) if necessary



- Mock transport exercise in am before opening at noon, Monday 20th
- Site visit conducted; met with EMSA, CalMat IMT, Mercy/Navy Leads, Costa Mesa FD
- Over 75 MDs, RNs, Corpsmen receiving facility orientation
- 4 buildings available & prepped for 25 beds each
- Requested daily admission log once patients received
- CDPH to send out All Facilities Letter (AFLS) to advise Hospital/SNFs of admission criteria & transfer protocols
