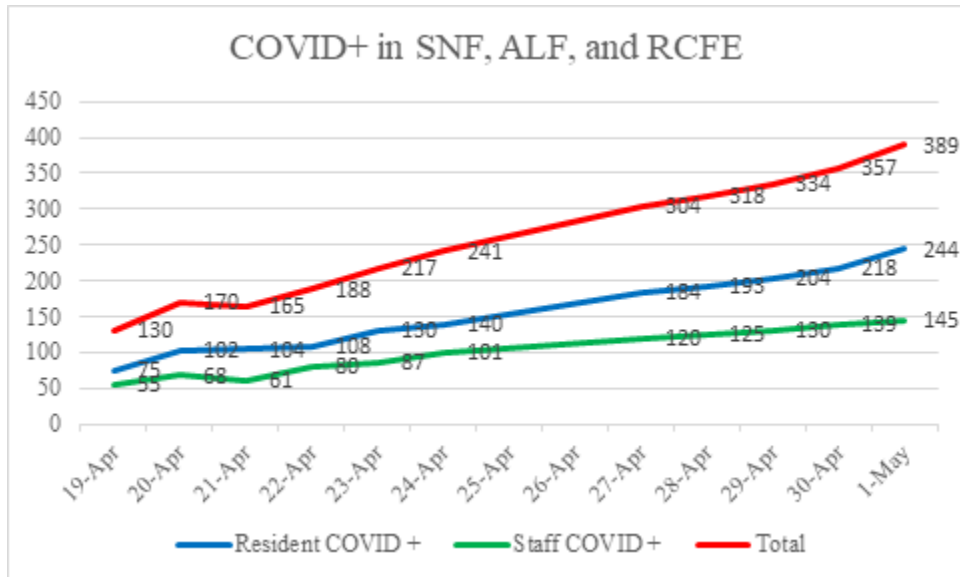

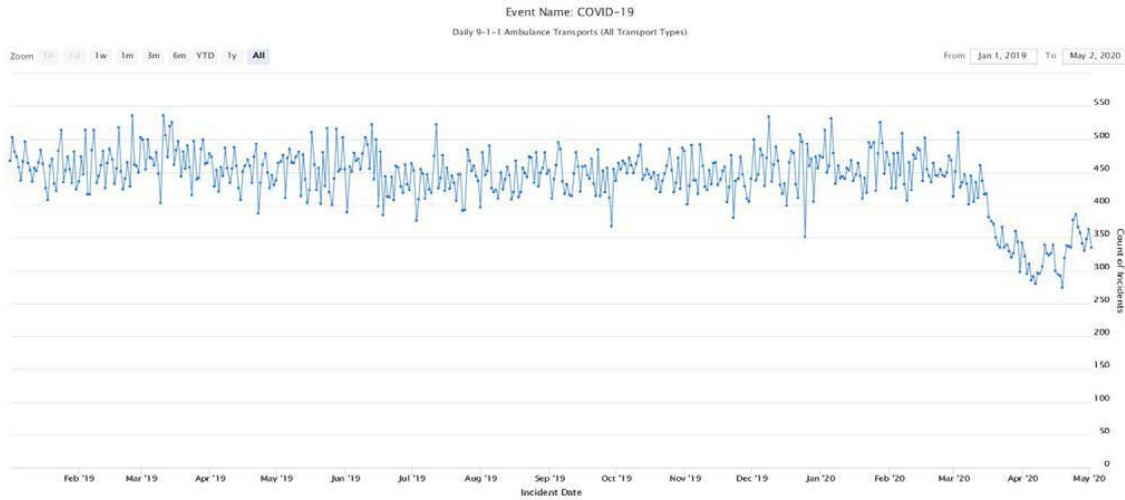

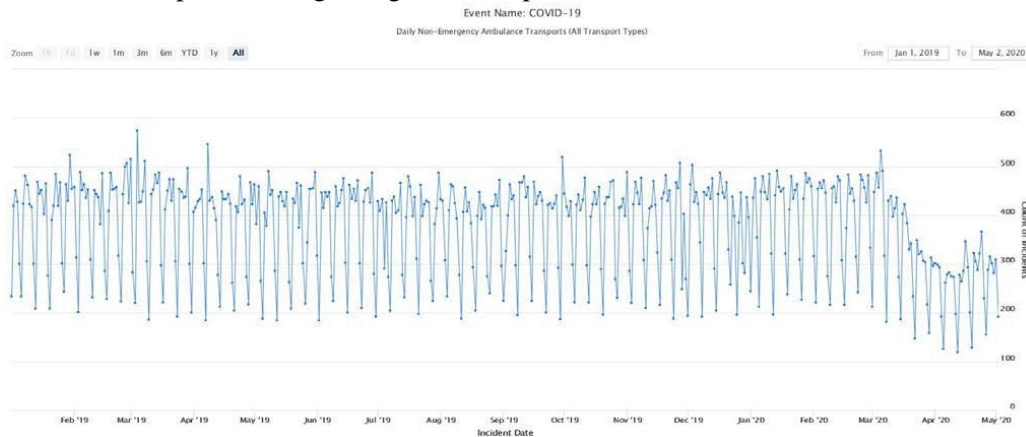
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EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES STATUS (full reports on [EMS Website-Notifications Archive](#))

- 9-1-1 ambulance transport volume remains 25-30% below normal. Below is an illustration of the transports since 1/1/20.



- Non-emergency ambulance transports are beginning to trend upward and are now about 45% below their normal average.



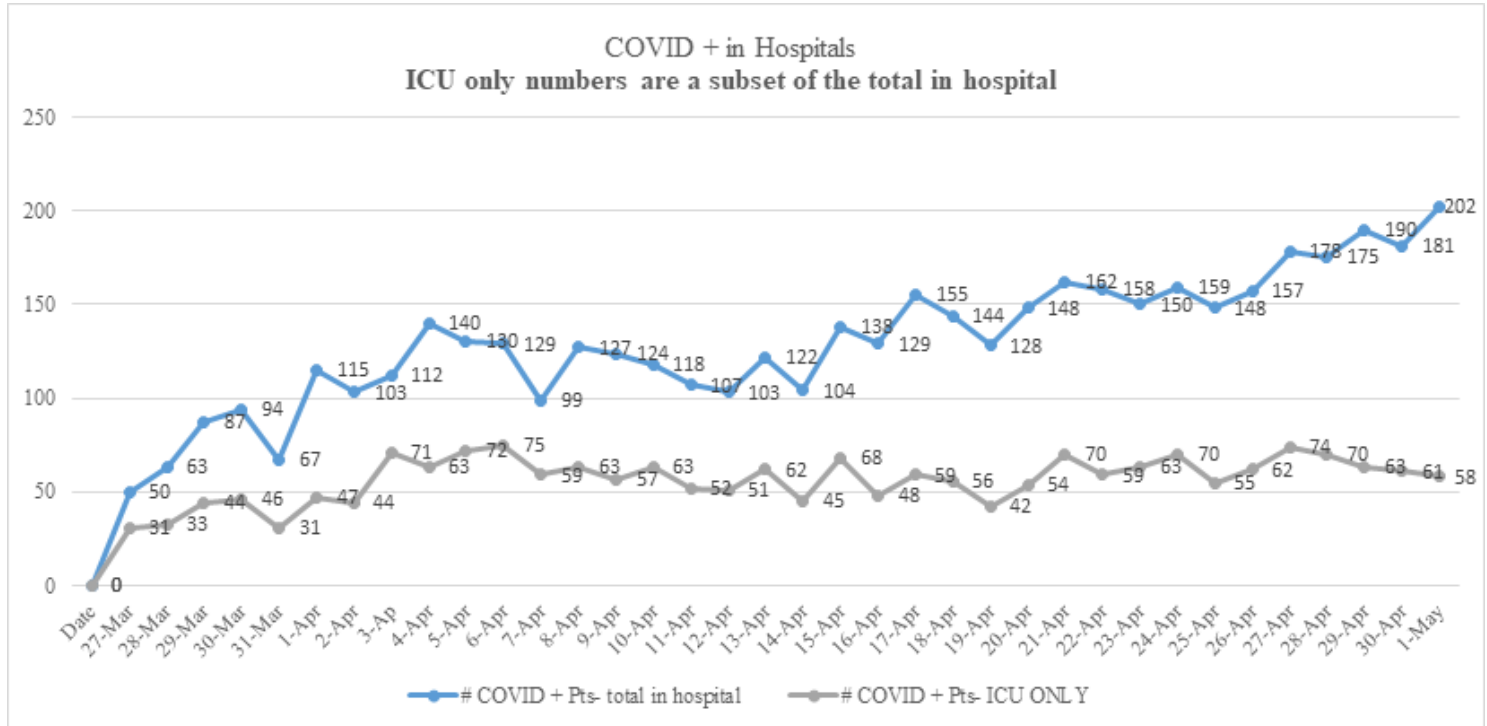
- Ambulance Patient Offload Time (APOT) is defined as the time the ambulance arrives at the receiving destination (wheels stop) to the time that the ambulance crew physically transfers the patient to the ED gurney. The illustrations below show the average and 90th percentile APOT for all 9-1-1 ambulance transports to Emergency Departments for the last 24 hours.

Current Average APOT is 10m27s / Current 90th Percentile APOT is 20m38s.
