## **Food Vehicle Restroom Agreement**

A Mobile Food Facility (MFF) that stops for more than one hour to conduct business at a single location is required by the California Retail Food Code Section 114315 to operate within 200 feet travel distance of an approved and readily available toilet and handwashing facility, to ensure that restroom facilities are available to MFF employees. Approved restrooms consist of those that are currently inspected by this agency such as those at a retail food facility (i.e. a permitted restaurant or market). Other approved facilities are public restrooms (not a private residence) that are available for inspection by this agency and that are properly equipped and maintained.
