This issue of the In+Care newsletter provides tips for keeping Persons Living with HIV (PLWH) engaged in care as well as resources to help clients with various needs during the COVID-19 pandemic.

## **Putting the CARE** in Healthcare

It is important to discuss treatment adherence and continued attendance of routine medical appointments with clients to ensure positive health outcomes for PLWH.



### Consider All Options

Talk to clients about telehealth options for services (both medical and



supportive) to reduce person-to-person contact, if available. Also, inform clients to follow up with their health care provider/pharmacy about the option to switch to a 90-day supply of medications and/or mail delivery service to limit visits to the pharmacy.



# Advise clients to follow these steps to help prevent the spread of COVID-19:1

- ✓ Wear a face cover in public.
- ✓ Avoid close contact. Stay at <u>least 6</u> <u>feet apart from others.</u>
- ✓ Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- ✓ Clean and disinfect often, especially surfaces such as phones, doorknobs, and countertops.
- ✓ Cover coughs and sneezes with an arm or use a tissue.
- ✓ Avoid touching the face.
- ✓ Stay home if sick.
