Our Services...

We provide 24-hour mobile response services to any adult who is experiencing a behavioral health crisis or may need evaluation for hospitalization.

The CAT program is able to accommodate multi-lingual/multi-cultural needs in Spanish, Vietnamese, Korean, Cambodian, Arabic and Tagalog.

We assist law enforcement and social service agencies with assessment and consultation for adults in need of:

- ◆ Evaluation for hospitalization as necessary
- ◆ Crisis intervention and risk assessment
- ◆ Resource and linkage
- ◆ Follow-up services
- ◆ Education

Our CAT responds 24/7 to psychiatric emergency calls throughout Orange County at locations such as:

- ◆ Law Enforcement Locations
- ◆ Private Residences
- ◆ Health Clinics
- ◆ Therapist Offices
- ◆ Private Doctors
- ◆ Emergency Departments
- ◆ Anywhere in the Community

CAT is a program of the Orange County Health Care Agency, Behavioral Health Services and is funded through the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA).



The Psychiatric Emergency Response

Team (PERT) consists of behavioral health clinicians who ride along with assigned law enforcement officers to address behavioral health related calls in their assigned city. PERT provides all the same services as CAT and also initiates involuntary hospitalization as necessary.
