Call to Order at 9:08 a.m. by Michael Rose.

Welcome and Introductions

- Pledge of Allegiance
- Each member and attendee introduced themselves and their respective affiliation.

Approval of Minutes – Action Item

- January 27, 2016
 - Richard McConaughy made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 27, 2016 meeting and Judith Lewis seconded the motion with corrections. The minutes were approved for the record. Vote: 7 yes/ 0 no

Behavioral Health Services (BHS) Director's Report – Jenny Qian

- Jenny updated the board on county and contract services. In Adult and Older Adult Behavioral Health, there are currently thirteen (13) Psychological Emergency Response Teams (PERT) actively working and the department is working on adding the Santa Ana Police Department. Also, the policy for discontinuing a 5150 prior to being admitted to an inpatient unit is being updated to include licensed (MFT/MSW) designated staff. Additionally, the Wellness Center in Garden Grove opened for business on Monday, February 22, 2016 and the Wellness Center South will have their Open House on Monday, February 29, 2016.
- In Children, Youth and Prevention Behavioral Health, Prevention & Intervention (P&I), the two first round Innovation Programs, OC4VETS and OCACCEPT, transitioned to P&I and will be overseen by our Navigation Unit. Moreover, the first Community Mental Health Education Stigma Event for 2016, called "No Stigma" Art Event will begin in March. The target population will be primarily adolescents and young adults who are currently enrolled in a High School or community college. The first Art Event is scheduled to take place on March 5, 2016.



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BHS Report Continued

- In our Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Administration, the HCA released a Request for Proposal (RFP) on February 9, 2016 to look at the cost-benefit of MHSA funded programs. This evaluation will include community wide gaps and needs assessment in addition to the cost-benefit evaluation. Also, the MHSA Annual Plan Update for FY 2016-17 is being finalized and will be presented to the MHB followed by a Public Hearing. Details on the dates will be released shortly.
- Finally, Annette shared information about the County's expanded 5150/5585 policy. The newly updated policy refers to designated facilities in Orange County. It allows for an expansion on individuals who can discontinue an involuntary hold within a designated facility. This expansion includes designated personnel such as Nurse Practitioners and licensed clinicians (Marriage and Family Therapists and Masters Level Social Workers).
