



The California Immunization Registry (CAIR) System

- Consortium of 10 regional registries – no current data linkage
- 7 of 10 use same 'CAIR' software (87% of population; 51 of 61 jurisdictions)
- The 'CAIR 7' registries are hosted at UCB and managed by CDPH/IZB staff





CAIR 7 – Staffing



What is the CAIR2 Project?

- Project Goals
 - Merge 'CAIR 7' regional registries into a single state registry 'hub' called CAIR2
 - Replace current legacy software with new SW (Wisconsin Immunization Registry, used in 17 other states, including NY and TX) that is state-IT compliant and supports the 'meaningful use' EHR Incentive Program (HL7)
 - Data share with the 3 'independent' CAIR registries (SD, SJ, Imp) to allow statewide patient search and record retrieval

CAIR2 - Why Phased Rollout?

- New software is quite different so training will be required
- Large number of Users will need to be trained (>12,000)
- Limited training staff




CAIR2 – New Features

- New look, feel!
- Faster, better performance!
 - Real-time access to submitted data, e.g. POS
- More robust, timely reporting!
 - Separate 'Datamart' database for reporting only
 - Push-button Co-CASA-like reports (Assessment, Benchmark)
 - 'Ad hoc' reporting capability
- New user roles!
 - County epi role gets access to all county data; no more need for county-specific specialized exports
 - Health Plan users can upload claims/billing data or directly run HEDIS reports
 - School Users can assemble class list and run grade compliance reports
- DX submitters will be able to run doses admin/inventory reports
- Real-time, bi-directional HL7 messaging capability
- Access to statewide patient data



CAIR2 - What's Next?

- Imperial County will likely move to CAIR 2.0!
- AFIX Integration- no more Co-CASA
- ?Direct parent/patient access to immunization record
- ?Automatic entry of VFC shipments
- ?Population of myVFCvaccines ordering form with CAIR inventory data
- ?'Dashboard' reports for providers
- ?2D bar code integration
- ?USPS address standardization
- ?Geocoding of addresses

CAIR2 - Data Exchange (DX) Sites

- All DX sites will begin submission to CAIR2 on the Phase 1 switchover date (October 3, 2016)
- DX sites in Phase 2 and 3 regions (BA, CV, LAO):
 - Will continue to access their submitted patient data in CAIR1 until they transition to CAIR2
 - Existing users will receive training as scheduled for their specific regions

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

CAIR2 - HL7 Message Change




CAIR2- Data Sharing with 3 'Independent' CAIR Registries (Summer-Fall 2016?)

CAIR2 - BiDX Timeline

Nov-Dec 2016

- 'Beta' test handful of sites (large), monitor system performance
- Require interested Sites to complete online <u>BiDX</u>
 <u>Interest/Readiness Survey</u>

April 2017

- Begin BiDX 'testing' as self-directed process using dummy patients in CAIR2
- Approve sites for BiDX when sites confirm that EHR has accurately displayed returned patient data



Training



User Training Plan

<u>Active Existing</u> Power and Regular users: Will be required to attend training. Register via new training registration system.

- Sufficient trainings will be scheduled to ensure that all Active users can attend training before the switchover date.
- Will offer up to 2 simultaneous trainings 3-4 times per day (webinar/live; some early mornings, evenings and Saturdays).

Inactive Existing Power and Regular users: Accounts will be deactivated. Required to obtain a new User Account and attend New User Training. Register via existing registration system.



Training – Monitoring and Support

During the Transition, we will:

- Monitor registration and add trainings as needed.
- Have a user feedback process to modify training curricula, materials and schedule as needed.
- Offer a weekly 'Ask The Trainer' webinar for users to ask questions post-training.
- Have user guides, videos, and on-screen Help Pages.

Post-Transition Training

After the Transition, we will:

- Continue Regular and Power user trainings for New Users.
- Create additional Guides and Cheat-sheets as needed (e.g., Reminder/Recall, Special Reports)
- Implement new User role trainings and additional Special Topics trainings as needed (e.g., Health Plan User, County User, Reminder/Recall, Special Reports)



Board of Pharmacy - Pending Regulations

- Under review by Dept. of Consumer Affairs: Approval expected early 2017
- Establishes training, continuing education, notification and recordkeeping requirements for pharmacists who administer vaccinations.
 - Improve provision of ACIP-recommended vaccines.
 - Requires timely communication with the primary care provider (and prenatal care provider, if pregnant).
 - Requires reporting immunizations administered into the state and/or local immunization registry and informing patient/guardian of immunization record sharing preferences.
 - Notifications must take place within 14 days of vaccine administration.

CDPH Adult IZ Grant - Pharmacies

- Expand pharmacist role in adult immunization
 - Establish a Statewide Pharmacy Task Force
 - Survey pharmacists about current IZ activities and support needed
 - Identify best practices and develop a 'Toolkit' for expanding and supporting pharmacies adult IZ activities and use of CAIR
- CAIR-specific activities
 - Survey other states that have registry mandates for pharmacies
 - Educate pharmacies about the new CA IZ Registry mandate
 - Develop a landing page on CAIRWEB.org
 - Dedicate a staff member to support data submission by pharmacies
 - Enroll, train and and provide ongoing support for pharmacies using CAIR
