II. Public Comment

- Ms. Cindy-
 - Ms. Cindy provided information about The Cambodian Family Center, and expressed
 of her support for the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Community Opportunity
 Fund (COF), in particular any activities that would benefit the Cambodian Families.
- Michael Arnot
 - o Mr. Arnot shared information about the MHSA COF and advised the board and the public of his availability in answering any questions or concerns on the COF. In addition, Mr. Arnot provided a handout on the COF.

 - Ms. Tolbea provided information on the State Council on Developmental Disabilities (SCDD), and emphasized the need to empower smaller local agencies to better target the community needs.

- MHSA Community Opportunity Fund
 - Or. Jeff Nagel provided an overview for the challenges being presented by several programs in community who have tried contracting with the County and in looking for other funding mechanisms. In addition, he explained in detail the process in contracting out through the County's Procurement process for MHSA funding or services.
 - O Susie Kim from County Procurement Office, provided a comprehensive overview and outline of the Health Care Agency's robust contracting process. She explained of the challenges smaller agencies can encounter and provided some useful information that would be beneficial when attempting to submit a Request for Proposal (RFP). In addition, Susie added information of a new guideline beginning August 1st, which will require presentations of all incoming proposals; this will make the contracting process a lengthier process.
 - Matthew Holzmann proposed for Michael Arnot to write a 1-2 page document to include the organizations that are not being met and include the population they serve. In addition, the MHB decided to form an Ad Hoc to identify the needs of the County and address the MHSA COF. In addition, they will identify the needs for services but not for funding. Joy Torres and Sandy Finestone volunteered to be a part of this Ad Hoc, an email will be sent out to obtain further participation from the board.
