INDICATION:

Means to provide naloxone for reversal of opioid overdose.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Cardiac arrest
- Nasal bleeding or obstruction
- Reported allergy to naloxone (extremely rare)

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Provide supplemental oxygen as tolerated.
- Withdraw appropriate dose of approved medication into syringe.
- Attach nasal atomizer to syringe.
- Place tip of atomizer within the nostril.
- 5. Compress syringe to administer ½ (one-half) of the syringe volume as an atomized spray within nostril.
 - ► Maximum volume of 1 mL per nostril.
- 6. Administer the balance of the medication into the opposite nostril.

nathenia

- Maintain open airway and assist ventilations as required.
- If repeat dose of medication is needed:
 - A. The atomizer and syringe used for the first dose may be re-used.
 - B. Divide volume of medication equally between both nostrils.

DOCUMENTATION:

- Document time and route of each dose of medication administered and the patient's response.
- Document pulse oximetry, level of consciousness and respiratory effort every 5 minutes.

NOTES:

Key point: always administer one-half (1/2) of the total drug volume into each nostril.
