Still trending down.</li> <li>AOC still supporting logistics for vaccination pods, slowing down services</li> <li>Resource request are being accepted for 30 days PPE supplies from the state.</li> <li>General use PCR test have run out of supply, but general public may still order them online.</li> <li>BinaxNow are specially allocated to SNFs and outpatient clinics.</li> <li>iHealth test kits available, received a new supply for health care workers return to work.</li> <li>Based on CDPH reference to Cal OSHA requirements self-conducted tests are acceptable if they are CLIA waived and confirmed by a proctor.</li> </ul>
