- The County also has testing kits still available. We have BinexNow specifically allocated for Outpatient Clinics and iHealth Kits available for over-the-counter testing. If you are interested in the kits, please let us know.
- Oral therapeutics are not in our control. They are allocated by the state and the people who receive them are also determined by the state.
- The UCI campus has an overstock of 16 oz hand sanitizer bottles that they would like to donate. If you are interested in those, please reach out and we would be happy to supply those to you.
- HEM is in the process of filling two of our vacant positions, possibly three
- We have a team working on a big disaster cache project with all of the hospitals
- We are developing a training calendar. Once it is complete it will be shared with the Coalition.
