2	OCHCA Update - Dr. Grewal Report - Mike Chiles	 Case rates are decreasing, currently 10 cases per 100,000. Less than 25% of the last peak. Hospitalizations have decreased, reports are around half the case are found incidentally. CDC recommends receiving a booster outside of Primary series, in order to be qualified you must be at least two months post you last booster/primary series. Monkey pox cases are rising but the case rates appear to be decreasing. Over 230 cases in Orange County. Demographics for infected remain similar but beginning to shift. Contact precautions are key for this infection. Tracking on Rhinovirus and Enterovirus in pediatrics due to increase in patients and hospitalizations. AOC has a small surplus of PPE, contact team to request. Majority of inventory is gowns and face shields. BinaxNOW kits are still available and available for healthcare workers, please contact county for supply. Over the counter kits are also available but being reserved for individuals without easy access.
