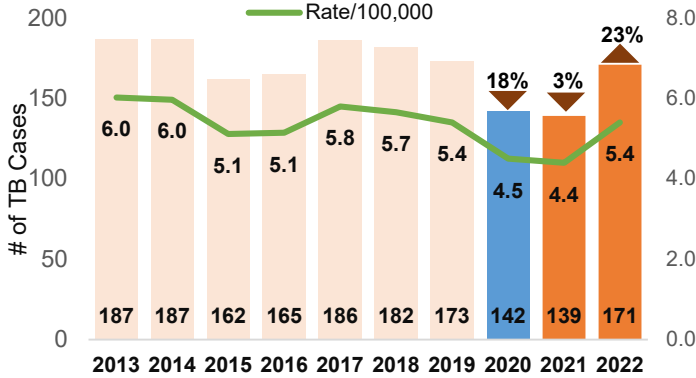

TB Trend



171 new cases reported in Orange County in 2022 **5.4** cases per 100,000 persons

1,843 new cases reported in California in 2022 **4.7** cases per 100,000 persons

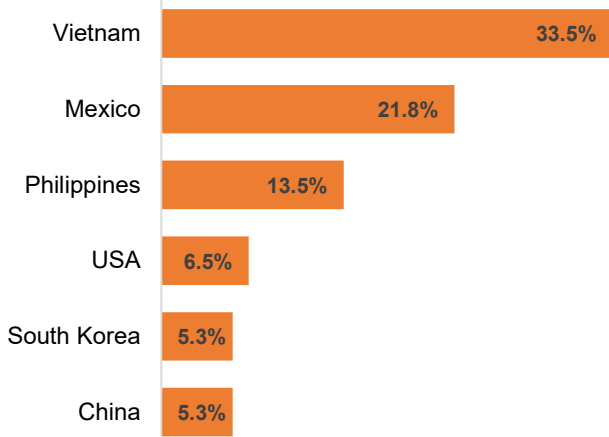
Country of Birth

9 out of **10** TB cases occurred among non-U.S. born persons

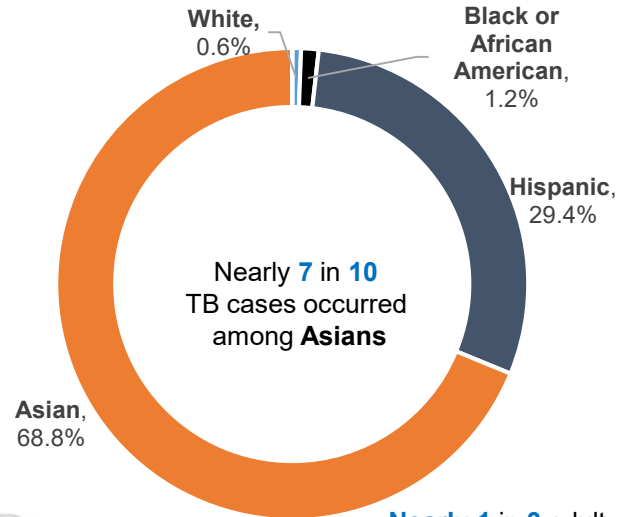
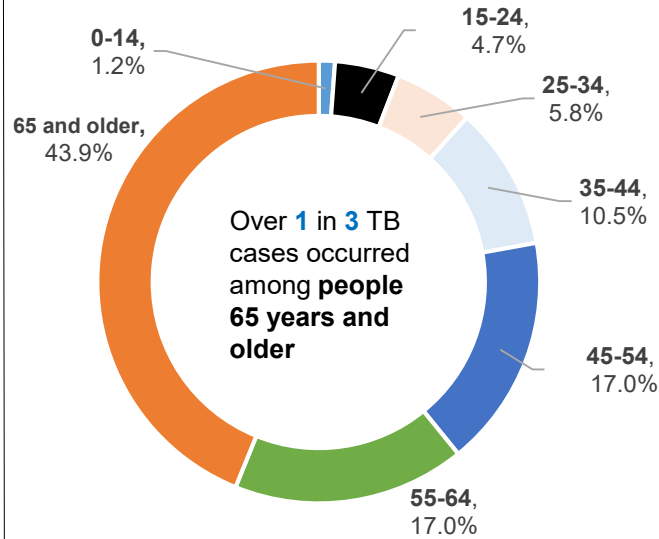


20 Number of countries of birth represented among patients with TB disease

Who is Getting TB?



Over 1 in 3 adult TB cases had **diabetes** **Nearly 1 in 3** adult TB cases were **current or past smokers**

Latent TB Infection (LTBI)

TB germs can live in the body **without making people sick**. This is called LTBI or inactive TB. People with LTBI can become sick in the future if not treated. **In Orange County, >200,000 people have LTBI.**



People at increased risk for TB should get tested



Treating LTBI prevents TB disease

Focusing efforts to screen for and treat LTBI is key to eliminating TB disease in Orange County
