



## FACILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE ORANGE COUNTY EMS FACILITY DESIGNATIONS January 9, 2024

The following hospitals have applied to Orange County Emergency Medical Services (OCEMS) for Emergency Receiving Center (ERC) and/or Specialty status (Cardiovascular Receiving Center/CVRC, Stroke Neurology Receiving Center/SNRC, Base Hospital/BH and Comprehensive Children's Emergency Receiving Center/CCERC) designation or re-designation. This report summarizes the OCEMS review of their applications noting deficiencies, conditions and recommendations. Today, it is presented to the Facilities Advisory Committee for committee endorsement.

*General Findings:* The following facilities currently meet the designation requirements for Emergency Receiving Center and Specialty Center designation, when applicable. Endorsement considerations of designation are for one to three-year terms or otherwise specified as recommended by committee.

<u>Criteria Deficiencies</u>: No Deficiencies found in any of the five designations.

The following are recommendations for improvement. Action is expected but not contingent on redesignation.

**ERC Recommendation 1:** Continue to monitor and balance APOT and diversion times to maintain compliance.

**ERC Recommendation 2:** Continue to closely monitor and manage compliance of H.E.A.R. drills, ReddiNet MCI drills, HavBed polls, and Patient Census polls.

**CCERC Recommendation 1:** Continue the process of ongoing recruitment of board-certified pediatric emergency physicians.





**CCERC Recommendation 2:** Continue to emphasize and promote pediatric specific competencies for both nursing and medical staff.

**CVRC Recommendation 1:** Provide community education regarding the utilization of 911 to help decrease the number of walk-in STEMI transfers from Mission Laguna.

**CVRC & SNRC Recommendation:** Consider collaborating with pre-hospital care providers by offering educational sessions and case reviews.

**BH Recommendation 1:** Build and strengthen working relationship with local fire agencies.

BH Recommendation 2: Increase Base Physicain involvement with paramedic quality of care.

Endorsement Consideration: Three (3) years (11/2023-11/2026)
