Program Highlights

Adult & Older Services:

- In January, Telecare at Orange (TAO) Central FSP program graduated 7 members and supported 6 members to move into permanent housing.
- MHRS attended the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the Casa Paloma housing project in Midway City on 1/25/24. Casa Paloma will offer 71 new housing units, which include 21 general affordable units and 24 of the 48 permanent supportive housing units are funded through MHSA, providing safe, affordable housing with wraparound services for coming from homelessness. The additional 24 MHSA units have OC Housing Authority Project Based Vouchers. This project is the first time Housing for Healthy California funding is layered with MHSA funding (10 units).

Crisis Services:

• The Mobile Crisis Benefit went live on 12/31/23, crisis responses were being provided by dyads. Services in the dyad response model are operating on 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year as required by the Mobile Crisis Benefit. The Crisis Assessment Team is actively collecting outcome data on the newly implemented process to continue to be as effective as possible in supporting the community in Orange County.

Forensics:

- The Westminster Probation Office has officially opened for AB 109 screening effective 1/19/24, they have completed two screenings since their start.
- Our AB109 System Navigator collaborated with Correction Health Staff and started a weekly 1-hour medication assisted treatment (MAT) psycho-education group at Theo Lacy and has now expanded to offer one group at Men's Central Jail.
- Graduations:
 - Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) FSP Mental Health Diversion had one graduation from Diversion on 1/25/24, and was able to get her charges dismissed.
 - Two Veteran Court graduations took place in January 2024, both had their charges dismissed. One of the graduates completed 5-years of Veteran Treatment Court and is currently enrolled for a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Programing.

Children and Youth Services:

- CYS Clinical Evaluation Guidance Unit (CEGU) clinicians provided a Trauma and Resilience Training to Social Services Agency (SSA) Orangewood Shelter residential staff and continue to build on the trauma-informed care approach within the Shelter. The training was met with much appreciation as Orangewood has been challenged with several youth in recent months who demonstrate significantly complex trauma histories.
- CYS collaborated with Social Services Agency to move forward a proclamation to declare January 2023 the third annual Positive Parenting Awareness Month in Orange County.

 Two CYS County-operated outpatient clinics are midway through Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) training and certification, with upcoming training and certification planned for the remaining outpatient clinics. PCIT will enhance our ability to serve the 0-5 years of age population.
