- A. 1) Prop 1 overview- Michelle Smith

Michelle explained SB 326 and AB 531 which included information on the funding and how it should be utilized. SB 326 will change how counties provide services, changing MSHA funds from 5 components to 3 major buckets. Those areas include: Housing Interventions, Full Service Partnerships, and Behavioral Health Services and Supports.

Michelle provided information on opportunities that exist under the bond funding. There is opportunity to apply for locked housing for older adults that meet BMSA criteria, Participate in INN planning, Build on INN Project for sustainability, and build a continuum starting from Early Intervention moving forward, and Older Adult FSP.

Karyl would like to look at ways on how this committee can come up with recommendations and strategize with MSHA for the BMSA planning.

Christine asked how the County plans to involve CalOptima. Michelle mentioned that BMSA has been having conversations with CalOptima to figure out how to work together.

Helen suggested focusing on what we will have available with BHSA and see the opportunities within. It looks like there will be a better vision for Older Adults.

Linda questioned if assembly bill 1082 can make its way into paying for Board and Care.

Karyl would like to focus on putting together recommendations around Prop 1 and making a formal recommendation for the BHS Director and Board of Supervisors. Karyl asked if Hasan can get a list of PEI programs- he will look into and get back to Karyl soon.
