SUBJECT: California Emergency Medical Services Information System (CEMSIS) Critical Patch

On January 20, 2025, President Donald Trump signed Executive Order 14168 stating that the U.S. government will recognize only two sexes, male and female. To comply with this executive order, the National Emergency Medical Services Information System (NEMSIS) Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) released a critical patch for NEMSIS V3.5 and for V3.5.1 on April 7, 2025. CEMSIS is scheduled to release this critical patch (schematron update) on June 3, 2025. The current data elements for gender will be deprecated and new data elements will be created for sex and will have the following values: male, female, unknown, not applicable and not recorded.

The following deprecated data elements will be mapped to the new data elements:
