- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this policy is to create and support a safe, welcoming, and respectful atmosphere for the HIV Planning Council (Council) and its committees.
- 2. <u>APPLICATION</u>: This policy applies to all members of the HIV Planning Council and its committees in all matters related to Council business, both during and outside meetings.
- 3. <u>**RULES**</u>: The Council has established the following rules of conduct for its members and committee members:
 - 3.1. Homophobic, racist, sexist, and other discriminatory statements are strictly prohibited in meetings.
 - 3.2. We value differing interests and opinions and encourage members to present ideas to the table for discussion and advocacy.
 - 3.3. We acknowledge that individuals may have special communication needs and make every effort to meet any special needs of Council members and guests.
 - 3.4. We are specific and use examples to define what we mean.
 - 3.5. We provide feedback to each other in a constructive and respectful manner.
 - 3.6. We focus on the issue, not the person raising the issue.
 - 3.7. We avoid unnecessary side bar conversations.
 - 3.8. We base decisions on accurate and reliable data.

4. ENFORCEMENT OF RULES:

- 4.1. All members of the Council and its committees are responsible for following the rules and reminding others to do the same.
- 4.2. The officers of the Council and its committees will ensure that meetings are facilitated in a way that fosters adherence to the rules.
- 5. <u>VIOLATION OF RULES</u>: The Council and its committees may address violations in a manner deemed most appropriate, as follows:
 - 5.1. Council Chair or Committee Chair(s) may meet with the individual to address the incident or behavior that is in violation of the rules.
