2. Baseline Data: Started with reviewing slide 8 from last workgroup meeting.

- Data Discussion: Are there any medical restrictions when transferring from other counties/other states? What is the eligibility to receive housing? So far is the population, which states that you must be chronically homeless in OC.

- How are we going to prevent those who are at risk of homelessness?

Per Christina Weckerly (co-chair): We haven't seen anything for prevention; but there are rental subsidies, but we haven't seen anything else for housing.

Per Judson Brown (co-chair): How many individuals are connected with CalAim already? Also, we can't pay for anything CalAim is already paying. Where is Cal Optima with reimbursement? Per Cal Optima representative: We are looking at over 800,000 individuals. Cal Optima can also do a presentation in a future workgroup meeting to address some of these questions.



- Other data considerations? There is a big data set coming for 2025 for those that are unsheltered homelessness, with 840 point in time surveys based on 84 questions. It took 30 days to collect this data set.
- CES data and COC data can be helpful information as well. Judson Brown (co-chair) will work on getting the COC data.
- We are also expecting to receive BHSa data.

3. Housing Interventions:

- What is allowable: The policy manual is the guide for what is allowable.
- A suggestion was made to include numbers in the systems map and adding current allocations to the map.
- There are some identified gaps depending which funding is being utilized and what must be exhausted first.
