Using the Barcode Scanner in Elite Field to Link Patient Records
Training for EMS Field Personnel

Introduction:

The OC-MEDS system has been integrated with the electronic medical records system at **Hoag Hospital – Newport Beach** and **Hoag Hospital - Irvine** which allows your PCR to be ingested into the receiving hospital's system and enables outcome data pertaining to your incident to be transmitted back to your agency. To link the patient records, an **Encounter Number** (known as the **Contact Serial Number, or "CSN"**) and a **Medical Records Number (MRN)** needs to be added to your PCR to establish a matching record in the hospital's system. This information can be obtained from the patient's **facesheet** once your patient has been registered in the emergency department.

Procedure:

- Locate the QR code on the **facesheet** as shown.
- The QR code includes the **CSN** and the **MRN** which will populate into your PCR when scanned.
- **Scan the barcode using the procedure noted below.**

To use the barcode scanner in Elite Field to add the CSN (Encounter #) and MRN to your PCR

1. On the "Destination" panel; Select "**Hoag Memorial Hospital Presbyterian**" or "**Hoag Hospital Irvine**" in the "Destination/Transferred To, Name" field.
2. The "**Hoag Data Exchange**" panel will display.
3. Tap on the "**Scan Destination Facility Barcode**" button.
4. Tap "Allow" to access your device's camera.
5. Position your camera over the **QR code on the factsheet as shown above.**
