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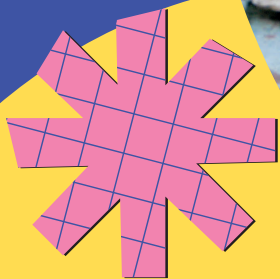

HCAC works together to:

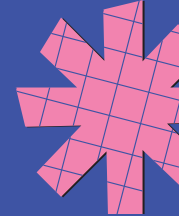
- Listen to the community and share feedback

## HOW TO JOIN

INTERESTED?

- **Need help getting there?** Members may qualify for transportation services. (must meet certain qualifications)
