### **OC Rescue Mission Strong Beginnings**

Provides a faith-based 90-day emergency shelter with supportive services for female victims of human trafficking. Women who are using substances can be admitted into the shelter, but if they need medical detox (such as with alcohol and opioids), they must detox before they can begin the intake process. Eligibility: - 18 years and older - Must be women, must be victims/survivors of human trafficking
