Using the Barcode Scanner in Elite Field to Link Patient Records

Introduction:

The Orange County Medical Emergency Data System (OC-MEDS) has been integrated with the medical records system at **MemorialCare hospitals including – Long Beach Memorial Medical Center, Orange Coast Memorial Medical Center, and Saddleback Memorial Medical Center – Laguna Hills**. This connection allows your PCR to be ingested into the receiving hospital's system and enables outcome data pertaining to your incident to be transmitted back to your agency. To link the patient records, additional information (**Contact Serial Number** and **Medical Record Number**) needs to be added to your PCR to help establish a matching record in the hospital's system. This information can often be gathered by **scanning a QR code** on the patient's facesheet once your patient has been registered in the emergency department. Alternatively, **the information can be keyed in manually**.

Locate the **QR code** at the **bottom of the facesheet**. Scan the **QR code** to add the "Contact Serial #" (CSN) and Medical Record # (MRN) to your PCR. **The CSN is a twelve (12) digit number and does not include any alpha characters.**

1. Select "Long Beach Memorial Medical Center" or "Orange Coast Memorial Medical Center" or "Saddleback Memorial Medical Center – Laguna Hills" in the "Destination Name" field.
2. The "MemorialCare Data Exchange" panel will appear.
3. Tap on the "Scan Destination Facility Barcode" button.
4. Tap "Allow" to access your device's camera.
5. Position your camera over the **QR Code**, the system will add the CSN / MRN to your PCR.
